What happened?

- Military coup 1st February 2021: Democratically elected government was dissolved, representatives were imprisoned, murdered or forced to flee; peaceful protests were crushed by military armed forces.
- Consequences of the military coup: 3.6 million internally displaced people, more than 53,000 dead (as of May 2024), more than 22,000 arrests, at least 4,300 air strikes (as of January 2025) against its own population, at least 90,000 civilian buildings destroyed by the military, freedom of expression and freedom of the press no longer exist.
- Economy is on the ground; Access to health care, infrastructure and education severely restricted.



Who are we?

- Our association was founded by people who lived in Myanmar and worked in development cooperation, business or the cultural scene
- However, many of our new members are simply interested in Myanmar or were there as tourists
- You are welcome to get involved with us for Myanmar!

What do we stand for?

- Immediate release of all political prisoners
- Recognition of the democratically elected Hluttaw (Parliament) as legitimate government institutions
- Imposition of international sanctions against the military leadership and military companies
- Ending all international economic relations with the Myanmar military and its corporations



What have we achieved so far?

- Support of local aid organizations for those affected by the March 2025 earthquake
- A German company halts material deliveries for the junta's banknote production
- Expulsion of the Myanmar military attaché by the German government in 2022
- Successfully communicating our demands in dialogues with political decision-makers
- Our political and cultural events have raised awareness of the situation in Myanmar
- Together we are stronger: actions with other organizations working for Myanmar
